Information for attending church services under current UK government guidance

We are planning, Lord willing, to begin opening our Sunday worship this Sunday 12th July. If you are able to join with us we would like you to be aware of the following

- If you, or any member of your household is symptomatic, please stay at home (and join us online if you can)
- Please bring your own bible.
- When arriving at church please remember to social distance.
- If there is a queue to get in please wait at the marked socially distanced points.
- Upon entry please use the provided hand sanitizer (facemasks will be available if needed)
- You will be asked to leave an address and contact if we don't have one.
- Please enter the main hall following the 'one-way' system arrows and sit in a seat appropriate to the number in your party.
- If you need to use the toilets, please note that there is a one in one out policy. All children must be accompanied to the facilities. Please use hand towels.
- During the service we will be adhering to the guidance laid out by the government
 - There will be no singing.
 - We must avoid projecting our voices.
 - We must avoid physical contact with those outside our household.
 - If you develop symptoms at any point you will be asked politely to leave.
- At the end of the service please remain in your seat until indicated by the steward
- Please note:
 - There will be an offering basket for offerings on a table at the exits.
 - Communion will be served using individual cups only and pre-cut bread in line with guidance.
 - Congregating outside the church will be discouraged.

We realise that all this is strange and awkward but it will still be great, for those able to do so, to be together.
